


CREDIT CARD FRAUD

How to Recognize and React

Credit card fraud is a risk that merchants are exposed to when accepting credit cards as a form of payment. This risk varies based on the environments card payments are excepted in and the industry type. The presentation will discuss these risks and mitigation considerations.
